## Overview of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation

With the objective of providing free water supply connections to the urban poor, the Government of India in collaboration with the Government of Odisha completed 130 projects in the state in accordance with the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT). This is a national flagship programme under which an investment of ₹1,415.68 crores was utilised to set up a two-taps connection across nine cities of Odisha. The project directed 25% of the total project cost specifically towards setting up water supply in the slums of Bhubaneswar,

### Scope

AMRUT 2.0 was kick started in 2022-2023 wherein 124 water supply projects and 18 water body rejuvenation projects were undertaken in Odisha. A total of ₹2,850.11 crores were allocated for the successful implementation of the said projects. Utilisation certificates for projects amounting to ₹1,607.64 crores were received in 2022-23 alone. The Odisha Urban Infrastructure Development Fund (OUIDF) is acting as the financial intermediary of AMRUT and works as Mission Directorate for Management of Funds. The Odisha Government has successfully received the final set of funds from the Government of India under AMRUT and is now running over 4 urban supply projects. Meanwhile, various other projects are progressing across the state under AMRUT 2.0.





## Progress so far



97% of the urban area has access to water after a set up of a total of **285.14 km** of distribution pipe network.




Water treatment plants with total treatment capacity of **133 MLD** at Sambalpur and Cuttack.



**28** Ground level Service Reservoirs and **6** Elevated Service Reservoirs with a total storage capacity of **27.31 ML**.



The number of ULBs receiving **100%** household connections has increased to **105** since a total of **21** ULBs were added to the list in 2022-23



In 2022-23, a total of **114** ULBs procured **100%** pipe network upon addition of **7** ULBs



Water supply connections to **9.86 lakh** houses has been set up by the end of December 2022.
