Overview of the programme

Technology has left no stone unturned in easing our work and life. Digital presence is now more common and familiar. Digital Door Numbering is a digital infrastructure led project and is a fundamental requirement to ensure essential public services, easier communication and logistics. Through this technique, individuals and their houses can be traced more conveniently. Currently Housing & Urban Development Department (H&UDD) is carrying out comprehensive Digital Door Numbering across the ULBs of Odisha. As a part of the programme, a unique Alpha Numeric Smart Address code for each property or establishment in respective ULBs will be generated. Each property will have its own identification and the ULBs will be able to track down details on electricity, water connection, property tax and fee collection management at any given point of time.

Scope

The Digital Door & Street Numbering (DDN) initiative was launched across 112 ULBs of Odisha by the Housing and Urban Development Department. Under this programme over 91,000 street boards will be affixed in the state by the end of December 2023.



Over **13.80 lakh** DDNs have been generated to date.
