The SHPSC may co-opt members from other State Government Department / Organizations and may invite experts in the field to participate in its deliberations.

2. The key responsibilities of the State HPSC are as under:

- i. Approve State Water Action Plan (SWAP) and accord administrative approval of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs)
- ii. Monitor Mission Including Progress of Projects, capacity building, IEC campaign and reform implements, etc.
- iii. Recommend proposals for release of instalment of funds for projects to the Centre.
- iv. Finalise State and ULB share of funds to ULBs in time.
- v. Allocate and release of Central and State share of funds to ULBs in time.
- vi. Encourage and facilitate state-ups and private entrepreneurs to participate in Mission through technology sub-Mission.
- vii. Approve plans for capacity building, issue notifications etc. For speedy implementation of reforms.
- viii. Advise State Mission Director on Operation & Maintenance of plants erected under the Mission.

3. Tenure of the State High Power Steering Committee is co-terminus with completion of AMRUT Mission Programme.
