The Department is operational under the mandate of 5T Governance Mantra. The Urban Odisha have bagged number of National and International awards and accolades and have received laurels across the globe. There are 115 Urban Local Bodies, 16% of the population lives in urban areas, covering 4%of the entire landmass of Odisha.

JAGA Mission: Transforming Slums into Livable Habitat

- Urban Infra rejuvenation under MUKTA 2.0- 6500 urban amenities created with an investment of 500 cr.
- 20000 Rain Water Harvesting Structures have been created under the "Catch the Rain Campaign". Another 2000 in pipeline
- Jalasathis to be scaled up to all 115 ULBs. 1000 Jalasathis to be engaged.
