

Slum Dwellers Association (SDA)

Slum dwellers associations were formed during USHA survey, to assist the technical team in collecting household data and identifying the slum boundaries. SDA is a 10 member committee elected by the slum community. 50 percent of the SDA membership is reserved for women. The committee comprises president, secretary, treasurer and seven general members. SDA represents their slum and would raise concern before the ULBs as and when needed. SDA maintains resolution of their meeting, brings it to the knowledge of ULB upon requirement. SDA can have its executive committee for day to day operation.
